We ultimately received a diagnosis that allowed him to receive critical supports at school."

Savannah and Tyler's mom continues, "Since beginning their journeys with Simple Changes, both children have made incredible progress. Our kids gain confidence every time they ride. The bond they have built with the horses is truly special."
